Letter from the President and the Director

The year 2022 has been a year of consolidation for IBEI, during which several large ERC research projects were initiated, and the number of master's students has significantly increased, particularly compared to a few years ago. Currently, IBEI has two Erasmus Mundus programmes running, which have also played a crucial role in the Institute's institutional consolidation. Additionally, IBEI has been continuously building extensive scholarly networks in Europe and beyond. However, IBEI is not just about numbers; over the years, it has evolved into a dynamic community with diverse voices. At present, our community consists of approximately 80 dedicated scholars and administrative staff members, along with a broader teaching staff comprising active professionals and faculty members from our partner universities. Within this vibrant community, we foster a culture of rich and intricate conversations, nurturing shared discourses and mutual understanding on pressing issues within the realm of international affairs. As evidence of this, the number of workshops and seminars organized at IBEI during this year has grown significantly, including the International Seminar on the Future of NATO, which IBEI organized in collaboration with the Spanish Foreign Affairs Ministry a few weeks before the summit in Madrid.

The persistence of war in Europe, a growing world polarization and regionalization, or the multiple challenges of international security and development are highly debated topics. Pursuing the master's programmes at IBEI has given students the opportunity to contrast these issues from different perspectives and values with fellow students and teaching staff from around the world. They have also gained insights into the intricacies of global governance and the significance of leadership in shaping global public policies. In this sense, we encourage diverse interactions at IBEI concerning current world challenges and the nuances of addressing international politics and globalization challenges. These interactions will substantially support and enrich students' professional careers in the future.

Promoting excellent research lies at the core of IBEI's aims, and 2022 has witnessed a significant expansion of research productivity, with an increase in the number and quality of articles and books published by IBEI researchers. We anticipate this trend to continue in the coming years, enabling our researchers to gain broader visibility and take a leading role in significant research topics. Moreover, we aim to facilitate the transfer of knowledge to policymakers and concerned citizens more generally. Consequently, we expect IBEI faculty to be even more engaged in global conversations and to make relevant contributions that enhance the understanding of global governance, security, and development. IBEI's internal diversity, focusing on relevant problems cutting across different academic disciplines while maintaining connections with a large number of international scholarly and professional networks, will likely contribute positively to achieving this purpose.







Highlights of the 2021 Survey on Career Development

IBEI graduates are satisfied and recommend the MIR, MID, MIS and Mundus Mapp masters for their professional development.

IBEI 2021 report on the job placement of its graduates analyzes data obtained from a survey conducted during the summer of 2021 of all its graduates from 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020.

This is the fifth time that IBEI has carried out this systematic survey, which aims to collect data every two years on the employment conditions of graduates, and the impact that IBEI's master's degrees have had on their professional careers.

The following conclusions can be drawn from the data analyzed:



Chances of employment are high after graduation



They build networks in international institutions, private companies and NGOs



+ Than 85% of graduates find a job during the first year after completing the Masters'



About half of the survey respondents have a permanent contract



60% of IBEI graduates work in the global and multinational scope



44% of graduates earn more than 40K after 5 years of graduation







Equality Plan 2022-2026


In 2022, IBEI approved the Equality Plan and the Protocol for the Prevention, Identification & Resolution of situations of sexual harassment and harassment based on sex, sexual orientation and gender identity.

IBEI has made a bold commitment to gender equality as one of the strategic principles of its institutional and human resources policy, emphasizing the commitment to work for non-discrimination and to promote and encourage the necessary measures to achieve equal opportunities between women and men in the organization.

The Equality plan is an ordered set of measures, adopted after an assessment of context, whose objective is to achieve equality of treatment and opportunities between women and men and to eliminate discrimination on the grounds of gender, as well as on the grounds of sexual, affective and gender diversity.

The Protocol is a tool to intervene in situations of sexual harassment, harassment based on sex, sexual orientation, and gender identity or gender expression among members of IBEI community.





Institutional visits at IBEI

In 2022, distinguished visitors explored the activities and endeavours of IBEI, shedding light on its research, training programmes, and its inter-university nature.


In March, Joan Subirats, the Spanish Minister of Universities and Emeritus Professor of Political Science at the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona, engaged with IBEI's president, director, scientific committee members, and the co-coordinator of the Erasmus Mundus Master's Programme in Public Policy.





Subsequently, in November, Katie Stana, the Consul General at the United States in Barcelona, delved into IBEI's initiatives alongside the president, the director, and the IBEI-IEN Senior Fellow in American Foreign Policy and International Security. Stana's extensive diplomatic career and experiences in various countries enhanced the exchange, contributing to a broader understanding of IBEI's interdisciplinary approach and global outlook.





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The Fred Halliday Award 2022

The first edition of the Fred Halliday Award was celebrated within the framework of the Barcelona Summer School of the Mediterranean and Middle East, a joint initiative of IBEI and Blanquerna - Universitat Ramon Llull.

The award was given to Jamie Allinson, Senior Lecturer in Politics and International Relations at the University of Edinburgh where he teaches courses on the Politics and IR of the Middle East. He is the author of "The Age of Counter-Revolution: States and Revolutions in the Middle East" (Cambridge University Press, 2022) and "The Struggle for the State in Jordan" (IB Tauris, 2016, co-winner of the Jadaliyya Political Economy Book Prize).



Irina Ciornei wins The Gordon Smith and Vincent Wright Memorial Prize

Irina Ciornei, Ramón y Cajal Assistant Professor at IBEI, was awarded The Gordon Smith and Vincent Wright Memorial Prize for the article "Political Parties and Muslims in Europe: The Regulation of Islam in Public Education" co-authored with Eva-Maria Euchner and Ilay Yesil.

The prize is awarded by the editorial Taylor & Francis and the Editors of West European Politics Journal, who select the winning articles among the ones that make a significant contribution to the study of Comparative European Politics.



Five New Doctors at IBEI

Five predoctoral fellows from IBEI, namely Diego Badell, Carlos Bravo, Alba Huidobro, Shaswat Kumar, and Adrià Rivera, successfully defended their PhD theses as part of different PhD Programmes at Universitat Pompeu Fabra (UPF) and Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (UAB). With their diverse areas of expertise, their research covered a wide range of pressing global issues.

Diego focused on normative contestation in EU foreign policy, while Carlos examined the EU's crisis management beyond its borders. Alba delved into the role of leaders' characteristics on government formation, and Shaswat investigated regulatory arrangements and electricity governance in India. Lastly, Adrià approached political transitions through a case study on Tunisia. This achievement undoubtedly marks a significant milestone in their academic journey.



The 6th International **Conference of Development** Studies held at IBEI

On 8 and 10 June 2022, IBEI and the Spanish Network of Development Studies (REEDES) organized a conference at the premises of UPF Campus. The conference welcomed researchers, practitioners and social organizations interested in the current debate and practices of development and its relationship to societal issues and global governance.

The conference revolved around the core theme of the peace-security-development nexus, which gained further significance due to the emergence of the COVID-19 pandemic and its numerous economic and social ramifications. Around 200 participants met in Barcelona to share their latest research results in the field of development studies.



IBEI hosted an International **Seminar on the Future of NATO**

In collaboration with the Spanish Ministry for Foreign Affairs, the EU, and Cooperation, IBEI organized an International Seminar on the Future of NATO, which coincided with the upcoming Madrid Summit.

On May 27, distinguished academics and professionals specializing in international security gathered at IBEI to discuss the prevailing status of the transatlantic security alliance and NATO's strategic outlook in response to emerging security challenges. The seminar also focused on Spain's contributions to the Atlantic Alliance and explored prospects for the organization's further enlargement.





Roundtable Series on Human Rights Today

IBEI and The Social Observatory - "la Caixa" Foundation collaborated to organize a roundtable of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. The series also delved into the current state of specific human rights, including those pertaining to migrants, children, and women in conflict.

Esteemed academics, practitioners and young human rights activists convened at CaixaForum Macaya in April and May 2022 to engage in a thought-provoking dialogue centred around a fundamental question: Would it be possible to endorse the Universal Declaration of Human Rights in the present day?
